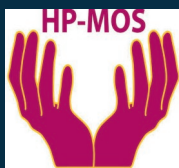

The fourth mobility meeting was held on 7th and 8th November 2012 in Turkey. The host was Etimesgut Halk Egitimi Merkezi (Public Education Center) which provides non-formal, non-vocational education for adult learners. The 12 participants included trainers and learners from the UK (HP-MOS, London - project leader), Poland (Bielskie Stowarzyszenie Artystyczne Teatr Grodzki, Bielsko-Biala), Turkey (Etimesgut Halk Egitimi Merkezi, Ankara) and Spain (Espiral Entitat de Serveis, Girona), Germany (Agentur für Grundlagen- und angewandte Forschung gUG) all participated in the meeting

On 7th November 2012 after the registration and meeting the participants, some information was given about Turkey, Ankara and Public Education Centers in Turkey.

On 8th November 2012 in the morning session participants practiced Ebru which is called marbling. It is an old

Turkish art of painting on oily water. They enjoyed participating in the activities and created very good



paintings adding their artistic skills. They took their beautiful works to their homes as a reminder of the practice.

In the afternoon evaluation questionnaires were filled, and for the final meeting in Spain M Merce Rovira gave some information. Project leader Mercy Maclean talked about the activities which should be followed by the partners to forward the Project.

Mobility meeting ended with a tour around the city and farewell dinner.
