The first prototype of the **App Generator** for the CMI2 project is now ready in all partners' languages. This ultra-simple app creation tool will enable managers, supervisors, mentors and job coaches to create simple 'task based apps' to empower workers and trainees with learning disabilities to work more independently. The **testing phase** is being implemented in all participating countries, specifically in Austria, Denmark, Hungary, Poland, Sweden and in the United Kingdom – and feedback to improve the App Generator collected among professionals.

Currently partners are developing various **Apps**, and the first apps are already available:

- How to greet visitors/customers
- How to use the cash register
- How to wash a t-shirt/item of clothing
- Making paper puppets
- Muscle relaxation
- How to make a paper bottle bag
- How to make a chicken bacon sandwich
